

Produced by the <u>Handweavers Guild of America, Inc.</u> (HGA), *Small Expressions* is an annual juried exhibit featuring contemporary small-scale works. The exhibit showcases small-scale works created using fiber techniques in any media, not to exceed 15 inches (38 cm) in any direction, including mounting, framing, or display devices. The exhibit is available for travel for a year.

Exhibit	 July 12 – August 23, 2025, Small Expressions 2025 is to be held at the Blue Ridge Mountains Art Association at The Art Center in Blue Ridge, Georgia, USA. Following the Blue Ridge show, the exhibit will tour the United States through June 2026. Tommye Scanlin is Professor Emerita at the University of North Georgia, Dahlonega, where she began the weaving program in the early 1970s. She explored different ways to create imagery with weaving until at last embracing handwoven tapestry as her medium of choice three decades ago. She is the author of <i>The Nature of Things: Essays of a Tapestry Weaver</i> and <i>Tapestry Design Basics and Beyond: Planning and Weaving with Confidence</i>. 		
Juror			
Jurying	HGA seeks to feature work that is not only of the highest caliber in craftsmanship and technical ability, but which also speaks to the intricacy of expression, the intimacy of design, thoughtful communication, and visual excitement.		
	The juror independently screens all images and makes the preliminary selection of all work in the exhibition. Entries will be evaluated on concept, design, technique, craftsmanship, and creative exploration.		
	Accepted work is subject to final approval by the juror's representative after the actual work arrives at the exhibition host venue. Work that exceeds the size limitation and/or differs significantly from the digital image representing it will be ineligible for the exhibition and returned to the artist.		
	Submission to <i>Small Expressions</i> implies that the artwork represented on the digital images will, if chosen by the juror, be available for the exhibition and that the artist understands that all accepted work, without exception, must remain for the duration of the exhibition.		
Eligibility	Works exhibited in previous Small Expressions exhibits are not eligible.		
	Submitted work is limited to works made using fiber techniques (interlaced, felted, stitched, dyed, coiled, knotted, pulled, spun, etc.) and can be of any material. All work must be of exhibition quality, completed within the last two years (since January 2023), and not previously published in any national or international print publication.		
	The size of the finished work may not exceed 15 inches (38 cm) in any direction including any mounting, framing, and/or display devices.		
	Work executed under classroom/educational guidance or supervision is not eligible.		
Image Requirements	Images must be submitted as digital images of completed work. A minimum of one (1) image of the entire artwork (including any framing) is required for each work. Additional optional images may include one (1) detail image and/or one (1) of the back of the work if it is a 3-D artwork.		
	Images may be color corrected to accurately represent the work but not enhanced in any way. Image editing is limited to cropping and adding or modifying a solid background of white, black, or gray.		
	The artist's name must <u>not</u> be visible on the digital image or your entry will be eliminated.		
	All images should be in JPG format using the maximum quality setting with at least 300ppi. The length on the long side of the image should be approximately 3000 pixels to have a clear, large image.

Entry Fees	 \$18 per piece for HGA Members \$25 per piece for Non-Members \$0 per piece for Students (If the artist does not have an active HGA Student Membership then a copy of the artist's student ID from an accredited educational institution must be uploaded when completing the Online Entry Form.) 		
Presentation	All accepted entries must be sent ready to show and exhibit.		
of Work	All work must be received ready to install. If work requires a specific hanging device(s) or armature(s), these must be included with clear installation instructions.		
	All entries must remain on display until the conclusion of the exhibit.		
Shipping	Shipping instructions will be sent after the acceptance notification. Work should be packed very well and shipped in a substantial reusable container. Artists must pay shipping and insurance costs to and from HGA. International return shipping may require valid credit card information. Contact HGA for details. No hand delivery of work will be allowed.		
Awards	First (\$500), Second (\$250), Third (\$100) place and Honorable Mention will be selected by the juror. Additional special criteria awards may be available. For updates, please check the HGA website <u>www.WeaveSpinDye.org</u> .		
Sales	Works in the exhibit will not be for sale.		
Liability	Exhibit artworks will be insured from the time of receipt for the insurance value indicated on the entry form up to \$2,000 and will be insured against all risks of physical loss or damage from any external cause while artworks are on location during the period of the loan. Insurance excludes loss or damage that occurs by any event beyond the control of HGA or the exhibition host venue.		
	During shipment, the insurance regulations of the shipping company will be in effect. The artist must provide any additional insurance.
