The Handweavers Guild of America, Inc. (HGA) invites students enrolled in accredited programs in the United States and Canada to apply for the annual HGA Scholarship. Scholarship funds are for furthering education in the field of fiber arts, including textile research, history and conservation; and **may be used for tuition only**. HGA Scholarship applicants can fall into one of two categories – artistic merit or scholarly research. Scholarships are awarded on artistic and technical excellence rather than financial need.

The scholarly research category is recommended for those applicants focused on textile research, history, conservation, etc., rather than artistic mastery.
